Mother Lange Needs You

Two dates stand out in recent memory which pertain to the cause for the canonization of Mother Mary Lange, OSP: One, May 8, 2010 His Excellence Edwin F. O'Brien, D.D., Archbishop of Baltimore, ce lebrated Mass at the mother cathedral of Catholicism in America, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, imploring God to grant us, the grace of witnessing the advancement of her cause for canonization. Sister Mary Alexis Fisher, OSP, Superior General of the Oblate Sisters of Providence, led the congregation in reciting the prayer for canonization of her orders' foundress.

Secondly, after appointing Father John Bowen, S.S. Vice Postulator for the cause in 2008, Father Wieslaw Spiewak, CR (Roman Postulator) noted that he was not an historian so he invited the former archivist of the Sulpician order in Baltimore to clarify certain historical points of the *Positio* which was originally sent in 2005 to help in the advancement of the cause for the Servant of God. On May 12 that was packaged and sent to Rome. Once, please God, the Congregation for the Causes of Saints scrutinizes and approves the documents recently sent, the Perfect for the Congregation will proclaim Mother Mary Lange, OSP Venerable.

Thereafter, the inquiry on "miracles" is to be conducted according to the norms of the New Laws for the Cause of Saints promulgated in 1983 by the late and Venerable pontiff, John Paul II. A miracle is a theological term reflecting an action undertaken by God which involves suspending the laws of nature. It serves as a sign of the saint's holiness and proximity to God. Translated in medical terms it reflects an extraordinary medical recovery or even a cure from a medical ailment. Well before 1588, when the canonization process was formally organized, the Office of Consulting Physicians was already established.

Consulting Physicians hold a primacy of place in the canonization process because they provide medical knowledge and objectivity which is necessary to safeguard against sensationalism of this process and without the testimony of a physician it cannot proceed. Therefore as part of this miracle inquiry "...the Bishop or his delegate is to seek help from a physician who is to propose questions to the witnesses in order to clarify matters according to necessity and circumstances".

(New Laws for the Causes of Saints, 1983 section 34a).

Once completed a transcript of inquiry with appropriate documentation is sent to the Sacred Congregation for scrutiny by the Consulta Medica, or council of physicians in Rome, and a vote. Once accepted this is turned over to the Congregation and with the pope's approval, Mother Lange will undergo beatification and thereafter proclaimed Blessed. Then another extraordinary medical recovery is to be sought to undergo scrutiny locally and then in Rome where, if approved ultimately by the pope, Mother Lange will then be canonized and proclaimed a Saint.

in a way as Mother Lange inspired us to do, always following Jesus, the Christ. Let us during this great season of Pentecost, totally turn our lives over to Christ. Let us break free from the small and narrow space of our own human experience and cross over to God's high octane surge of holiness and become "the great souls" that God has created us to be.

Spirit of the living God, fall afresh on us!
